ORDER :

In the G.O. 1st read above, orders were issued providing 4% reservation to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes of Muslims in the State in admissions into Educational Institutions and Public Employment. In the reference 2nd read above, Act No.26/2007 was enacted on 13.8.2007.

2. Aggrieved by the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No,23, Backward Classes Welfare(C2) Department, dated 7.7.2007, 10 Writ Petitions were filed challenging the 4% reservation provided to Socially and Educationally Backward Classes of Muslims in the State. In the reference 3rd read above, the Hon'ble High Court of A.P. has allowed the W.Ps. and quashed the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.23, Backward Classes Welfare(C2) Department, dated 7.7.2007 and the Act No.26/2007, dated 13.8.2007.

3. Government of Andhra Pradesh have decided to file SLP in the Supreme Court of India, against the judgment of High Court of A.P. to protect the interest of the beneficiaries, and accordingly, Government have filed SLP on 26.2.2010 against the judgment dated 8.2.2010 of High Court of A.P. For this purpose, Government have engaged the services of Sri A.Subba Rao, Advocate, Supreme Court of India, New Delhi, to assist the Senior Counsels, Sri G.E.Vahanvati, Attorney General of India and Sri K.Parasaran, Senior Advocate, to defend the State Government in the Special Leave Petition filed in the Supreme Court of India, against the majority Judgment 3rd read above.

4. In the reference 5th read above, Sri A. Subba Rao, Advocate, Supreme Court, New Delhi has agreed to defend the case on behalf of State Government of A.P. in the Supreme Court. He has furnished the following terms and conditions for having engaged his services, as Advocate to draft Special Leave Petitions, Rejoinder Affidavits, Miscellaneous applications etc.,

and to assist the Attorney General for India, Dr.K.Parasaran, Senior Advocate and Other Senior Advocates already engaged by the Government of A.P.:

Fees for Conferences with the Attorney General for India, Dr.K.Parasaran, Sr.Advocate and Other Sr.Advocates to be engaged by the Government of A.P., for discussion at the time of settlement of petitions and also at the time of hearing of matters, Sri P.S.Krishnan, I.A.S., (Retd.), Advisor to the Government and Officers of the Government connected with the matter.	Rs.20,000/- per day (irrespective of time consumed)
Fees for appearance before the Court	Rs.50,000/- per day
Clerical charges at 10% of the above said fees	

5. Government after careful examination of the matter, hereby accept the above terms and conditions offered by Sri A.Subba Rao, Advocate, Supreme Court, New Delhi.
